ADMISSION PROCESS

MBA (Masters of Business Administration)

Admission to M.B.A. programs shall be open to candidates who have passed their Bachelor's Degree with not less than 50% aggregate marks. (45% for SC/ST candidates belonging to Karnataka). The candidate must have also taken at least one of the prescribed Entrance exams as specified in the Admission Process below.

Students who wish to seek admission to Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme may do so through:

➤ **Post Graduate Common Entrance Test (PGCET) and Selection Process**

The Karnataka Post Graduate Common Entrance Test (exam conducted by www.kea.kar.nic.in) is conducted in the month of May / June each year. This test is a requirement for admission to colleges affiliated to Bengaluru North University. PGCET Counseling will be conducted based on the ranks that students (Karnataka candidates only) obtain in the written exam. Qualifying students can choose IA School of Management Studies at the time of Centralized Counseling.

➤ **Management Admission Process**

Admission through this process is open to both Karnataka and non-Karnataka students. Eligible students (those who meet qualifying requirements as per the eligibility criteria) may contact the IA School of Management Studies Admission Section in order to obtain the application form. Candidates will be selected based on their academic merit.

Note: Candidates must have taken one of the following examinations in order to qualify:

- Post Graduate Common Entrance Test (PGCET)
- Karnataka Management Aptitude Test (KMAT)
- Common Management Admission Test (CMAT)
- Common Admission Test (CAT)
- Management Aptitude Test (MAT)

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Internal assessment establishes standards through which the students are subsequently evaluated. The results are directly communicated to the students so that they continuously upgrade which will enhance their all-round development.

Mechanism of internal assessment

As per the Bengaluru North University 30 marks for Internal Assessment is assigned for individual subjects. For awarding of internal marks systematically the following is followed:

- Schedule of Class Assessment Test which is given in Academic calendar which is displayed well in advance before commencement of session.
- Evaluation method comprises of internal examinations held progressively during the semester and is designed to check and report the periodic performance of the student
- After Valuation, marks are displayed on dates mentioned in the academic calendar by faculty members. Assessment copies are shown to the students.
- Assignments are given to students for respective subjects.
- Respective faculty also may include any of the following activities for internal assessment which may be in the form of :
 1. Case study Presentation
 2. Role Playing
 3. Toast Masters
 4. Internal tests
 5. Book review
 6. Assignment
 7. Presentation
 8. Business News Analysis
